KITCHEN SCRAPS AND YARD TRIMMINGS

Meat, including bones

Dairy products

Breads and sandwiches

Spoiled, moldy food

Coffee grounds and filters



LOW-GRADE PAPER

Paper towels and napkins

Tissues and tissue paper

Paper towel / toilet
paper rolls

Paper bags (great
for storing kitchen
scraps)

Greasy pizza boxes and wet or waxed
cardboard

Small paper items

Shredded paper

Dark-colored envelopes

Neon, fluorescent, goldenrod,
and dark paper (not recyclable)



SPECIALLY-LABELED COMPOSTABLE PRODUCTS

#7 PLA bioplastic made
from corn (can include cups,
containers, and utensils with
"PLA" next to the recycling
symbol)

Compost bags made from PLA
"bioplastic"

Paper cups with a PLA lining
(must say "compostable")

Wax paper

PLEASE NO...

Plastics of any kind
Plastic-coated
paper plates, cups, or
other items

Liquids including
cooking oil or grease

Dryer lint

Dirt

Cotton balls or
cotton swabs (Q-tips)

Fabric scraps or string

Biohazards, including
diapers or sanitary items

Milk or juice cartons

(recycle with single-stream
recycling)

Please check in at the
window and bring
your current utility bill
indicating the Waste
Management fee.
