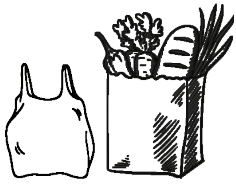


Why am I being charged a bag fee?

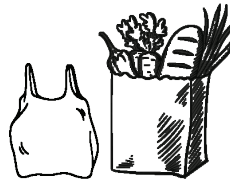
Starting January 1, 2023, paper and plastic checkout bags distributed at large Colorado retailers will incur a fee of at least \$0.10 per checkout bag.

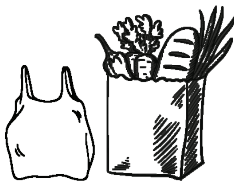
