Job Responsibilities

- 1. Daily presentations on a wide variety of environmental topics for PK-12th grade students in classrooms and field trips in Boulder Valley School District, St. Vrain Valley School District, and the City/County of Broomfield.
- 2. Additional supports, which may include:
 - a. surveys, web research, and email outreach;
 - b. preparation of materials including reports, fliers, letters, and emails;
 - c. monitoring school progress in collection of recyclables and compostables;
 - d. tabling, lunchroom monitoring, and other outreach and support of schools;
 - e. processing used books for the Children's Used Book Project;
 - f. assistance and coordination of special projects, as needed.
- 3. Miscellaneous duties such as purchasing supplies, delivering materials to schools, maintenance, and cleaning of program equipment.
